



## Salute to the Forces – Event Terms & Conditions

Please ensure that all Terms and Conditions are read thoroughly by all members of your booking party. We look forward to welcoming you to our very first Salute To The Forces Show and we would love for you to have a safe and fun weekend, so therefore we have to implement some rules and regulations

These Terms & Conditions ensure a safe, lawful, and enjoyable experience for everyone attending. By entering the event site, you agree to comply with all rules set out below and failure to do so may result in you being removed immediately without refund and barred from future events.

### 1. Site Operations & Vehicle Movement

#### 1.1 Speed Limit

A maximum speed of 5mph applies to all vehicles throughout the entire site from arrival onwards.

This applies regardless of any permanent site signage.

Dangerous or reckless driving may result in removal and possible prosecution under the Road Traffic Act 1991 (Sections 1–3).

No fuel transfer or decanting is allowed anywhere onsite.

#### 1.2 Vehicle Movement Restrictions

No vehicle movement is permitted between 09:00am and 5:30pm on show days unless expressly authorised and undertaken under the guidance of at least one marshal. Outside of show hours, vehicle movement must be limited to essential journeys only.

Unnecessary or recreational driving around the showground or through public camping areas is strictly prohibited at all times.

Hazard lights must be on whenever an engine is running.

Any essential movement must be escorted by an official marshal in hi-vis clothing.

### 2. Behavior, Conduct & Alcohol

#### 2.1 Expected Behavior

All attendees, participants, traders, and re-enactors must behave respectfully and responsibly.

Aggression, intimidation, harassment, discrimination, or any behavior that impacts or endangers others will not be tolerated.

Anyone acting inappropriately may be removed immediately without refund and barred from future events.

#### 2.2 Alcohol

Alcohol may be consumed responsibly in permitted areas.

Excessive intoxication, unsafe behavior, or the supply of alcohol to minors is strictly prohibited.

Anyone who becomes disruptive or unsafe due to alcohol may be removed from the site.

### 3. Noise, Fires & Smoking, (please also see section 5)

#### 3.1 Noise Restrictions

Noise must be minimised between 11pm and 07:00 am.

This includes music, engine noise, sirens, pyrotechnics, and gunfire (please see also section 5.

Weapons, Displays & Restricted Items)

#### 3.2 Open Fires & Barbecues



Open fires, fire pits, and barbecues are strictly prohibited anywhere onsite.

Any open flame will be extinguished immediately and may result in removal from the event.

### 3.3 Cigarette Waste

Buckets filled with sand will be placed in accessible areas for extinguishing cigarettes.

These buckets must remain upright, safe, and properly maintained throughout the event.

Cigarette waste must not be dropped on the ground or placed in mixed rubbish bins.

## 4. Generators

All generators must comply with UK safety regulations, including Electricity at Work Regulations.

Proper earthing and safe operation are required.

Any costs needed to achieve compliance are the owner's responsibility.

## 5. Weapons, Displays & Restricted Items

### 5.1 Weapons Allowed

Only:

Vehicle-mounted deactivated weapons

Secure static display weapons

All must comply with UK legislation, remain secured, and must not be carried around the site without written approval.

Blank ammunition and pyrotechnics are prohibited unless pre-approved.

### 5.2 Knives, Air Rifles & BB Guns

Knives must remain sheathed unless used in an approved demonstration.

Air rifles and BB guns may only be used at official designated ranges.

### 5.3 Weapon Sales

All must comply with UK legislation, remain secured, and must not be carried around without written approval from the chief marshal. Blank ammunition and pyrotechnics are prohibited unless pre-approved in writing by the chief marshal. Replica or blank-firing weapons require written approval from the chief marshal.

Sales require prior approval.

Certificates must be attached for inspection.

Replica or blank-firing weapons require organizer approval.

Inert explosive items must be proven safe and clearly labelled.

Organiser's do not inspect or certify weapon authenticity or safety.

## 6. Traders & Catering Requirements

### 6.1 General Trader Requirements

Traders must:

- Not be selling illegal or inappropriate items.
- Follow the Think 21 policy when awarding alcohol prizes.
- Hold £5 million public liability insurance.
- Keep a suitable fire extinguisher on their pitch.
- Ensure any on-site accommodation includes a working smoke alarm.
- Carry appropriate fire extinguishers suitable for the goods and equipment used.

### 6.2 Catering Vendors

Catering operators must provide:

- Valid Food Hygiene certification
- Gas safety and PAT testing documentation



- £5 million public liability insurance

Catering units must also:

- Have appropriate fire extinguishers (CO<sub>2</sub>, wet chemical, fire blankets)
- Have working smoke alarms
- Operate only with compliant electrical and gas systems
- Only approved licensed traders may sell alcohol.

## 7. Fire Safety & Emergency Procedures

### 7.1 Fire Safety

All traders and exhibitors must have suitable fire extinguishers.

Accommodation (tents, caravans, campervans) must have working smoke alarms.

Safety checks may be conducted.

### 7.2 Emergency Exits & Evacuation

Fire exits are clearly marked and shown on the event map.

Attendees must follow marshal instructions immediately during any emergency.

Marshals will direct visitors to safe routes and assembly points.

## 8. Liability

Salute to the Forces and Betteshanger Park accept no responsibility for:

Loss or theft

Damage to vehicles or property

Injury to people or animals

Attendees are responsible for their belongings at all times.

## 9. Data Protection

All data (except email addresses, see below) is securely destroyed after the event.

Email addresses may be retained for future event announcements unless you opt out.

## **Terms & Conditions for Camping at Betteshanger Park**

1. Camping arrivals are from 10.00am on Friday till 9.00pm. On Saturday arrivals are from 6.30am until 08.30am or after 5.30pm and Sunday arrivals are also from 06.30am until 08.30am. All pitches must be vacated by 10.00am Monday morning.
2. You need to be on site no later than 08.30am if you wish to access your camping pitch with your vehicle, otherwise you will have to park up and enjoy the show and access your pitch after the show closes at 5pm.
3. Only persons aged 18 years or over can reserve camping. Those under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
4. Salute to the Forces reserves the right to refuse any booking application or terminate accommodation at its absolute discretion.
5. We do our best to site parties of two or more units together if arriving at the same time but cannot guarantee this.
6. Please advise of any disabilities or special requirements at the time of



booking, Every effort will be made to ensure suitable pitches/facilities are available if we are notified at the time of booking.

7. We welcome responsible dog owners on the campsite. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times, in all public areas. Bag and bin your dog's poo in the campsite and off-site.

### **On Site**

8. Salute to the forces reserve the right to delay check-in times in order for all housekeeping and maintenance duties to be carried out.

9. No admittance to the campsite will be allowed after 9pm for new arrivals. New arrivals after this time will be parked in a late arrivals area and shown to their pitch in the morning.

10. Salute to the Forces shall not be liable if advertised facilities and amenities are not available due to circumstances beyond our control.

**11. Open flame fires, disposable barbecues and gas barbeques are prohibited.**

**Camping cookers may be used but, must be always raised off the ground ( to prevent fire spreading to the undergrowth) on a suitable and secure surface and never left unattended.**

12. You use the Campsite at your own risk and Salute to the Forces cannot accept liability for loss or damage in respect of your vehicle, equipment, personal valuables or property.

13. Campers are required to keep their pitch clean of litter and all waste by using the appropriate bins available. Campers are also responsible for cleaning their pitch and removing all property before departure.

14. Water is for personal use only. Water taps are for filling water containers only. Washing under taps is strictly forbidden. Washing cars, caravans or display vehicles is strictly prohibited.

15. We kindly ask that you inform us of any problems during your stay. We welcome your feedback to improve our service, however, we regret that we cannot be responsible for complaints received after you have left the campsite.

16. Unless you notify us of late arrival your pitch will be held until noon the day after your booked arrival date, after which time it may be re-let without notice.

17. The size of your unit (touring or camping) must be stipulated at the time of booking to ensure the allocated pitch is the correct size. If this is not done or the unit size alters, we cannot be held responsible if the pitch is the incorrect size.

18. Pitch numbers are allocated upon arrival. Should you be found to be sited on the incorrect pitch or outside of the designated area of your pitch you will be asked to move.

19. All pitches are approximately on grass and there is no hard standing.

20. Quiet hours are from 10pm to 7am. During this time, please respect your fellow campers and turn off all music and refrain from any loud activities or



noises. If another camper is disturbing you, please bring this to the attention of a show official.

**21. Use of fireworks or other explosions are strictly prohibited.**

22. Only registered campers are permitted in the campsite. Camping passes allocated on arrival must be worn at all times by all members of your party and be clearly visible. Failure to show a camping pass on request will result in removal from the campsite.

23. All campers must have a valid event pass for the duration of their stay.

24. Please obey all rules and regulations as failure to do so may jeopardies you and your parties stay at the event. Persons causing a nuisance to others may be evicted from the site without a refund.

25. Children MUST be supervised within the camping area at all times.
